# Reflections ~ Reflexiones:

## GOSPEL: JOHN 18:33b-37

What kind of king is Jesus? In this reading from the passion story in John's Gospel, Jesus provides us with his own answer. Pontius Pilate was the Roman official who held power in Palestine. He asks Jesus if he is the king of the Jews. Pilate really wants to know whether Jesus might be part of a Jewish revolt against Roman rule. Jesus assures Pilate that his kingdom is not of this world. He is not one who rules by force. However he is a king who came into the world to "testify to the truth." All who recognize him as "the way and the truth and the life" will hear his voice (John 14:6).

As the Church year comes to a close, we are grateful for the ways in which we have heard our King's voice in the liturgy this year. We consider how to live the words of Jesus more faithfully as the circle of the new liturgical year begins.

- 1.) Imagine that you are a Roman soldier who is present at Pilate's official residence as the prisoner Jesus of Nazareth is being questioned. What might you think when you heard Jesus' answer to Pilate's question, "Are you the king of the Jews?"
- 2.) Why might you be surprised when you heard Jesus describe his kingdom?

## EVANGELIO: JUAN 18:33b-37

¿Qué tipo de rey es Jesús? En esta lectura de la historia de la pasión de Jesús en el Evangelio de Juan, Jesús nos ofrece su respuesta. Poncio Pilato era un oficial romano, gobernador de Palestina. El le pregunta a Jesús si él es el rey de los judíos. Pilato realmente quiere saber si Jesús esa parte de una revuelta de los judíos en contra de Roma. Jesús le asegura a Pilato que su reino no es de este mundo. El no gobierna a la fuerza. Sin embargo, él es un rey que vine al mundo a "dar testimonio de la verdad". Todo el que lo reconoce como "el camino, la verdad y la vida" escuchará su voz (Juan 15:6).

Al terminar el año litúrgico, estamos agradecidos por las formas en que hemos escuchado la voz de nuestro rey durante al año. Consideramos como vivir la palabra de Jesús con más fidelidad al iniciar un nuevo ciclo.

- 2.) ¿Por qué te sorprenderías al escuchar a Jesús describir su reino?

# Pastor's Message ~ Mensaje del Párroco:

## TRUTH TO POWER



Today's Gospel reading shows that Pontius Pilate, the local governor of the powerful Roman Empire, did not know what to make of Jesus. Jesus was obviously not a mob leader or a con man. Jewish leaders said he claimed to be King of the Jews—a potential threat to Roman rule—yet he commanded no army. Jesus said, "My kingdom does not belong to this world." More importantly, he added, "I came into the world, to testify to the truth. Everyone who belongs to the truth listens to my voice" (John 18:36, 37). The Gospels clearly show the political maneuvering between Roman rulers and Jewish religious leaders; Jesus was a puzzle to them all. Pilate "found no fault in him." Jesus ruled by neither violence nor oppression; he simply witnessed to God's truth. Anyone seeking this truth has only to listen and to respond to become part of the kingdom of God. 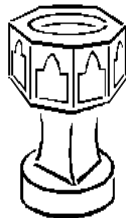
