GOSPEL: LUKE 3: 15-16, 21-22

We all want to be recognized for who we really are. Today's gospel reading describes that memorable day when Jesus had the joy of being recognized by John the Baptist and approved by God as "God's beloved Son." Although Jesus did not need to be baptized (since he was without sin), he wanted to identify himself as closely as possible with God's people.

Take a few minutes today to be thankful for your Baptism. Ask Jesus to help you recognize yourself more deeply as a beloved daughter or son of God.

- 2.) What can help you become more conscious everyday of God acting in your life?
- 3.) What can you do to help others become more aware of God's love?

APOSTLES OF THE GOOD NEWS

The baptism of Jesus may seem odd to us. John called the people to repent and be baptized and then urged them to go and live good lives. The Savior of the world needs baptism? Yet, as John foretold, the power of the Spirit pours upon Jesus. He is the Beloved Son, or as Saint Paul says, the one "who gave himself for us, to deliver us from all lawlessness and to cleanse for himself a people as his own, eager to do what is good" (Titus 2:14). Before his ascension, Jesus appeared to his *disciples* or followers. John, he said, had baptized with water, but they "in a few days . . . will be baptized with the Holy Spirit" (Acts 1:5). At Pentecost the power of the Spirit fills them. They become *apostles*—the ones sent forth with the Good News—healing, forgiving, binding up wounds, teaching, and preaching. We are disciples as we learn more about Christ, but also apostles. Saint Teresa of Ávila said:

"Christ has no body now but yours, no hands, no feet on earth but yours, yours are the eyes with which he looks compassion on this world, yours are the feet with which he walks to do good, yours are the hands with which he blesses all the world". APÓSTOLES DE LA BUENA NUEVA

El bautismo de Jesús pudiera parecernos raro. Juan le pidió a la gente que se arrepintiera y se bautizara, y la urgió a vivir una vida sana. El Salvador del mundo, ¿necesita el bautismo? No obstante, tal como lo predijo Juan, el poder del Espíritu descende sobre Jesús. Él es el Hijo Amado o, como dice san Pablo, el que "se entregó por nosotros para redimirnos de todo pecado y purificarnos, a fin de convertirnos en pueblo suyo, fervorosamente entregado a practicar el bien" (Tito 2:14). Antes de su ascensión, Jesús se le apareció a sus discípulos y les dijo que Juan había bautizado con agua, pero que ellos "dentro de pocos días...serán bautizados con el Espíritu Santo" (Hechos 1:5). En Pentecostés ellos quedan llenos del Espíritu y se convierten en "*apóstoles*"—los enviados con la Buena Nueva—a sanar, perdonar, curar heridas, enseñar y predicar. Nosotros somos discípulos a medida que aprendemos más acerca de Cristo, pero también somos apóstoles. Como dijo santa Teresa de Ávila:

"Cristo no tiene otro cuerpo en la tierra que el tuyo, no tiene otras manos que las tuyas, no tiene otros pies que los tuyos. Tuyos son los ojos a través de los cuales la compasión de Cristo mira a este mundo; tuyos son los pies que pasan haciendo el bien; tuyas son las manos con las cuales ahora El nos bendice". The divine Spirit is manifested in all of the scriptures for this feast. Psalm 104 highlights the Spirit of God creating and renewing the earth, while the reading from Isaiah describes God restoring Israel. In Luke's account of the baptism of the Lord the Holy Spirit descends upon Jesus. 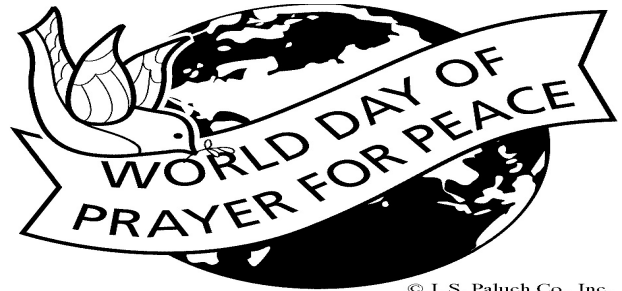
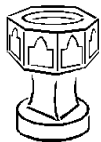
