# Reflections ~ Reflexiones:

## GOSPEL: LUKE 1: 1-4; 14-21

Just as Ezra, in our first reading, read to the people from Scripture, Jesus reads from the book of the prophet Isaiah about the Servant of the Lord. He announces that he is the fulfillment of Scripture. Then he tells the crowd in the synagogue that he is the one sent by God. His presence is their guarantee that a "year of favor," or time of salvation, has begun. All eyes are glued on him as he puts down the scroll and takes his seat.

1.) In this reading, Jesus identifies himself as the Messiah, as the one Isaiah foretold would come to the people. He did this at the weekly worship at his local synagogue. The gospel tells us that he was in the habit of worshipping there weekly. Why did Jesus worship weekly? What does this habit of Jesus' tell us about the importance of our weekly worship? Where do we meet Jesus, the Messiah, on a weekly basis?

## EVANGELIO: LUCAS 1: 4: 14-21

1.) En esta lectura, Jesús se identifica como el Mesías, tal como Isaías predijo que vendría. Hizo esto en la adoración se manal de su sinagoga local. El evangelio nos dice que Jesús tenía el hábito de adorar a Dios todas las semanas. ¿Por qué Jesús adoraba semanalmente? ¿Qué nos dice este hábito de Jesús sobre la importancia de nuestra adoración semanal? ¿Dónde encontramos a Jesus, el Mesías, todas las semanas?

# Pastor's Message ~ Mensaje del Párroco:

## KNOWING YOUR GIFTS

Participants at a women's day of reflection were asked to compile a list of what they perceived as their God-given talents. Some gazed out of the window, others chewed on their pencils, and a few wrote things down and then vigorously crossed them out. Finally the facilitator asked everyone to share their lists. Kerrin stood up. Many people there knew her well. She was deeply involved in service to others. She studied scripture, belonged to a prayer group, helped organize parish retreats, and ran a food pantry. She said, "I really had to think hard about this. I couldn't come up with a list, because I don't believe I'm that special. But my family says I'm a gentle person." There was an audible gasp of astonishment that Kerrin could not see her own gifts. Many of us may have never thought about what our real talents are, or we may think that to acknowledge them is to show undue pride. It is part of the adult life of faith, however, to recognize what skills and capabilities God has blessed us with and then decide, in gratitude, to use those gifts to help build God's kingdom here on earth.

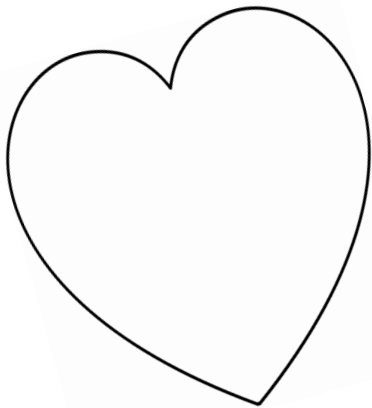

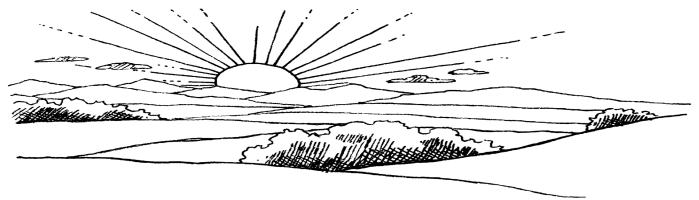

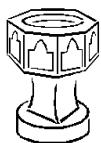
