## GOSPEL: JOHN 13: 31-33A, 34-35

Jesus is saying farewell to his friends at the Last Supper. He tells them that he will soon be "glorified." They still do not really get the message about his death and resurrection. They love him too much to face the reality of his crucifixion. So Jesus gathers them close and says, "My children, I will be with you only a little while longer." He tells them how they are to keep his presence alive within them after he is physically absent. "Love one another," he says.

# Pastor's Message ~ Mensaje del Párroco:

## BEYOND THE RULES

Certain religious groups have taken the banning of prayer in public schools as a threat to the expression of religion in public life. They have successfully lobbied many state and local governments to display the Ten Commandments in public buildings. Some claim that the commandments represent the moral and legal foundation of American society, showing "what this country stands for." Yet no one is advocating the public display of Jesus' words about loving God and neighbor (Matthew 22:36-40). Which is easier to do? Keep the rules, or love someone you dislike or even hate? Jesus says love your enemies, especially the personal ones: the colleague who got the big promotion, the daughter who promised not to drink but is arrested for DUI, the husband who has affairs, the company that scammed you out of hard-earned dollars. When we hear the One on the throne say "I make all things new" (Revelation 21:5), we are invited into a new world order in which we center our lives not only on rules, but on loving the unlovable. #### Treasures From Our Tradition:

The French Revolution swept the church in France away in an astonishing way, stripping the nation of every possible vestige of the faith, not merely shuttering churches, but using them as staging areas for pagan raves and romps. While millions of faithful simply went underground and hung on for the ride, even the seven-day week was demolished along with the names of the months. What emerged from the chaos was the Napoleonic Code of 1792 governing church life, and therefore marriage law in France, French Canada, and elsewhere. The code makes civil marriage mandatory for all citizens.

In practice, when the faithful marry, they go first to the City Hall. There, the mayor performs the civil marriage, usually accompanied by a patriotic speech about the duties of the citizen, particularly in the rearing of children. Then, typically after a lunch, everyone goes off to change into more festive attire for the wedding liturgy, featuring consent, the exchange of rings, and the nuptial blessing. Sadly, only a minority of citizens today celebrate even the civil form of the rite, and a fraction of those continue on to the church. For those who do celebrate the liturgy of marriage, however, there is near certainty that the spouses are active worshipers, and that they will later present their children for baptism.

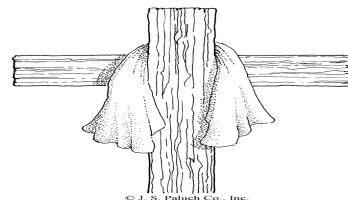

Its theme from Matthew 5:7, "Blessed are the merciful," echoes Pope Francis' warning that "the practice of mercy is waning in the wider culture." In intercultural witness, therefore, "the time has come," says Francis, "for the Church to take up the joyful call to mercy once more. It is time to return to the basics and to bear the weaknesses and struggles of our brothers and sisters." Jesus affirms the same in today's Gospel. "As I have loved you, so you also should love one another" (John 13:34). Francis concludes, "The Church's very credibility is seen in how she shows merciful and compassionate love." Jesus too asserts, "This is how all will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another" (John 13:35). Thus mercy "makes young" the Church, the world, and everyone. "Mercy is the force that reawakens us to new life and instills in us the courage to look to the future with hope" (*Misericordiae Vultus*, 10).

## Año Jubilar de la Misericordia:

Este domingo "Jubilar de la Juventud" es una muestra de la Jornada Mundial de la Juventud el mes de julio en la ciudad de Cracovia. El tema de la Jornada es "Bienaventurados los misericordiosos", haciendo eco a la advertencia del Papa Francisco de que "la práctica de la misericordia está disminuyendo ampliamente en la cultura". Como testigo contracultural, por lo tanto, "el tiempo ya llegó" dice el Papa Francisco, "para que la Iglesia aumente la invitación alegre a la misericordia una vez más, regresar a los orígenes, cargar las debilidades y dificultades de nuestros hermanos y hermanas". Jesús afirma lo mismo en el Evangelio de hoy. "Así como yo los he amado, así también ámense los unos a los otros" (Juan 13:34). El Papa Francisco concluye "la misma credibilidad de la Iglesia es vista en cómo muestra misericordia y amor compasivo". Jesús acierta al decir "en esto conocerán todos que son mis discípulos, si aman los unos a los otros" (Juan 13:35). Por lo que la misericordia "hace joven" a la Iglesia, al mundo y a cada persona. La misericordia es la "fuerza que resucita a una vida nueva e infunde el valor para mirar el futuro con esperanza" (*Misericordiae Vultus*, 10).
