Reflections ~ Reflexiones:

GOSPEL: LUKE 17: 5-10

The two sayings of Jesus in today's gospel make us wonder about the other side of the story. When the apostles ask, "Increase our faith," are they secretly quite satisfied with their record of faithfulness? Jesus tells them that if they really have faith they can tell a tree what to do, and it will do it! The story about the servant tells us that Jesus' disciples should be grateful to God. When we do God's will, we should not expect to receive a gold medal. We have, after all, done no more than "what we were obliged to do."

1.) What is your attitude toward the next good thing asked of you? Is it to stand around and quibble about it? Or do you say, "I'll get it! I'll do it! I'm on it!"? All Jesus asks is that we love one another, not that we just stand around *talking about* loving one another!

EVANGELIO: LUCAS 17: 5-10

Las dos cosas dichas por Jesús en el evangelio de hoy nos hacen preguntarnos sobre el otro lado de la historia. Cuando los apóstoles pidieron : "aumenta nuestra fe", ¿estaban satisfechos con su fidelidad? Jesús les dice que si realmente tienen fe pueden decir a los árboles lo que tienen que hacer y ellos obedecerlos. La historia sobre el sirviente nos dice que los discípulos de Jesús deben estar agradecidos de Dios. Cuando hacemos la voluntad de Dios, no debemos esperar recibir una medalla de oro. No hemos hecho más que lo que estamos obligados a hacer.

1) ¿Qué actitud tienes cuando se te pide que hagas algo? ¿Acaso te quedas parado quejándote? ¿O quizás pones "manos a la obra"? Jesús nos pide que nos amemos los unos a los otros. El no solo quiere que nos quedemos parados hablando de como amarnos, sino que realmente lo hagamos de corazón.

Pastor's Message ~ Mensaje del Párroco:

NO SHORTCUTS

Turn on a TV and you will find at least one ostensibly Christian preacher expounding on a strange theme: if you are a believer, God wants you to be rich. You become rich by giving to the preacher, who will do God's work for you, and then God will bless you with what you want. Based on unrelated scripture verses, this "prosperity gospel" is not good news. Jesus tells us that God's mercy and goodness are not a *result* of our gifts, prayers, or good behavior; God's generosity happens *first*. We are invited to change our hearts and trust in God to provide what we need, not to mail a check and wait for miracles to be delivered. Like the disciples in today's Gospel, we secretly wish that God would wave a magic wand, make our troubles cease, and give us whatever we want. Jesus tells us that is not God's way. It shouldn't be ours, either.

Al igual que los discípulos en el evangelio de hoy, nosotros albergamos secretamente el deseo de que Dios agite su varita mágica, para que cesen nuestros problemas y nos dé todo lo que deseamos. Pero Jesús nos dice que así no es como obra Dios. Tampoco debería ser la forma de obrar de nosotros.

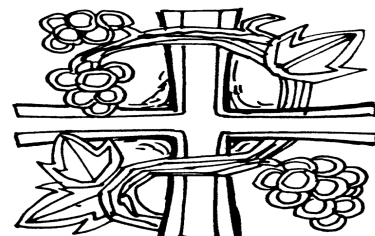
